

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

MONDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2023 1:00 p.m. – 2:15 p.m.

Summary of Major Actions and Discussion

Vice-Chair Dottie King called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The board of directors:

CHAIR'S REPORT

During the Working Session:

The Committee on Recognition informed the board that there was no action to be taken at this time.

During the Working Session the board introduced two new board members and a CHEA Fellow.

Also, during the Working Session the CHEA staff reported on a number of CHEA initiatives that included an update on the CHEA office space, a review of Form 990 and heard an in-depth Membership and Marketing report.

President Jackson Hammond also discussed a Leadership packet that was sent to over 750 college and university presidents in their first three years of leadership.

Special Assistant to the President Joel Espinoza announced that the 2024 CHEA/CIQG Annual Conference will be in-person and take place January 29- February 1, 2024, in Washington DC.

Government Affairs Report

Senior Vice President Jan Friis reported on the U.S. Department of Education (USDE) has scheduled a negotiated rulemaking to begin this October focused on student financial aid and that this has likely bumped the earlier proposed accreditation negotiated rulemaking. He reported that the Gainful Employment rule has been released and that this will affect CHEA member institutions. Friis also reported that U.S. House of Education majority is planning to propose a reauthorization of the Higher Education Act. This may include a number of smaller bills that have been introduced. In addition, he discussed USDE guidance on accreditor complaint procedures and the National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity Policy Subcommittee recommendations.
